When working together members must work in the spirit of cooperation, mutual respect and to share expertise and knowledge where they are able to do so.

Members must not discriminate against anyone on the grounds of age, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, race, religion or belief, or disability.

Members bringing the organisation into disrepute may have their membership terminated in accordance with the constitution.

When attending YoCo’s general meetings, Members are asked to abide by relevant organisational policies and procedures (see www.yoco.uk/membership).
